Subject: To open the link for submission of online proposal for approval of fees as well as intimation of 'No Upward

Revision' of fees for the academic years 2022-2023,

2023-2024, 2024-2025 & 2025-2026.

All concerned to take note that on due consideration of requests received from various Unaided Private Professional Institutions running **graduate and/or post-graduate courses affiliated to the University**, the Fees Regulating Authority decided to open the link for submission of online proposal for approval of fees as well as for 'No Upward Revision' of fees subject to payment of penalties as mentioned below;

- For academic years 2022-2023, 2023-2024 & 2024-2025 penalty of Rs. 2 lakhs per course for seeking 'Upward Revision of fees' and cost of Rs. 5,000/- per course for the institutions seeking "No Upward Revision" of Fees.
- 2. For academic year 2025-2026 penalty of Rs. 1 lakh per course for seeking 'Upward Revision of fees' and cost of Rs. 5,000/- per course for the institutions seeking "No Upward Revision" of Fees.

Before exercising the option for 'No Upward Revision' of fees for the academic years 2022-2023, 2023-2024, 2024-2025 & 2025-2026, the colleges/institutes must ensure that the fees for any such course/s run by their colleges/institutes was approved by the Authority for the previous academic years.

The link for submission of the online proposal shall remain open from 29/01/2025 and closed on 28/02/2025 till midnight. The hard copy of the proposals to be submitted within fifteen (15) days from the date of submission of the online proposal.

All concerned to take note and comply accordingly.
