This is in respect of the course stated during Academic Year 2012-13. The fee approved was Rs. 65,000/-. The Institute has raised the pointes that there is an error in disallowing printing and stationary expenditure. Attempt was made even to contend that it was an error in disallowing 10% salary, but the Institute was convinced about its correctness. There is some substance in the first point raised. The Institute has now demand fee of Rs. 67,000/-. The demand is quite reasonable. We approve the same. Office to take action.

## 4) MB3218: St. John College of Engineering and Technology, Palghar, Thane.

Samiti heard Mrs. Florince Creasta, Accountant and Arvind Shashi, Chartered Accountant on behalf of the aforesaid College/Institute.

The fee originally approved for 2012-13 of Rs. 75,000/-, while it was 68,240/- during Academic Year 2011-12. The College to produce all the details regarding expenditure on the cultural, sports and technical events and collection made from the students, if any, in this regard. The fee would be approved only thereafter (We have noted the letter dated 27/02/2013). Office to communicate.
